The features of the program would be as follows:

1. Total schedule - 4 weeks
2. Attending the out-patient department everyday
3. Assisting in the Operating rooms
4. To get involved in daily rounds along with the resident and fellows
5. Research - To be able to work on a project and publish it in a respected journal in the time-frame
6. The fellow will be trained in case selection and the nuances of using, docking and operating through narrow corridors (ports). Additional exposure in spinal navigation will get him/her oriented to the latest state-of-art infra-structure to carry out MIS surgeries with radiation safety and precision.
7. **Legalities/Certification:** This program is a short term observership just to give an insight into the spine surgery as a whole/into a particular sub speciality. This will not make the candidate legally eligible to practice spine surgery. ASSI will not get any certificate for this observership.
